Single Wills

A single will is a legal document used by one person to provide specific details of their final wishes.

Mirror Wills

A mirror will are two wills, usually created by spouses or partners, where the wishes of one person largely reflect the wishes of the other. Generally, the two people will leave their estate to each other, and agree where their estate should pass upon the death of the second person. It is one of the most common approaches for couples when preparing their Last Will and Testament.

Lasting Power of Attorney

We can also advise you on Lasting Powers of Attorney.

A lasting power of attorney (LPA) is a legal document which enables you to plan ahead and set out what you would like to happen should you become incapable of making decisions in the future. With mirror lasting power of attorney documents, this allows a couple or partners to act as power of attorneys if one or the other becomes incapacitated and cannot make decisions for themselves, the other will step in to do so.

Lasting Power of Attorney (LPA)

There are two types of LPA:

A property and financial affairs LPA. This gives your attorney the authority to deal with your property and finances when you choose and /or if you lack mental capacity.

A health and welfare LPA. This allows your attorney to make health and care decisions on your behalf if you lack mental capacity to do so yourself. This could include giving or refusing consent to the continuation of life sustaining treatment.

You can appoint one or more attorneys who will be able to make decisions on your behalf. They could be a family member, friend, or professional adviser. He or she must consider your best interest when making a decision for you, in a way you would want, when it is needed.
